- 1 Inspect aircraft for proper structural integrity, operation and balance.
- 2 Help set-up airplane motor and controls as needed.
- 3 Provide safety rules and regulations of airfield and aircraft operation.
- 4 Provide ground school on the basics of flight.
- 5 Perform test flight of aircraft for trimming purposes, using the buddy-box system, with the student.
- 6 Train the student through his/her first solo flight.
